- 2. **P**hysicians, nurses, and key workers working every waking moment under impossible conditions 'He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak.' (Is.40:29)
- 3. **P**oliticians rolling out the vaccine, trying to support hospitals, businesses and hold the nation together. 'I urge,
