was also the new Circuit Superintendent. Normally I would still be missing the previous incumbent and so I would have some mixed feelings about the new arrival: feelings that usually vanished almost immediately once I'd heard them preach and had chance to talk with them.

I'm sure many of you are wondering just who your new Circuit Superintendent is. I have visited the Circuit to take a few evening services in the summer of 2018, at Christ Church and Higherford, but I'm guessing most of you know nothing about me.

Officially I'm Richard, but everybody knows me as Rick. I'm originally from Poulton Le Fylde and before starting training for ministry I worked variously as a Civil Servant, Company Secretary and Library Assistant. I could never settle in any job, always feeling there was something else I should be doing, and of course I realised eventually I was feeling a call to be ordained as a Presbyter in the Methodist Church.

I have so far served in two Circuits as a Presbyter, Wharfedale and Aireborough which is based around the market town of Otley in West Yorkshire and West Pennine Moors Circuit, our neighbouring Circuit in this District. I am really happy that my third Circuit, and first as Superintendent, will be in the county of my birth.

I'm also really happy to have been invited to Burnley and Pendle Circuit because of family connections. My wife Sue was born in Burnley hospital and sent the early years of her life attending Carr Road Methodist Church, which of course is now Christ Church. Sue and her mum, who lives with us, are looking forward to worshipping at Christ Church where I understand a few people still remember them. There are also members of Sue's wider family still living in the area and we look forward to seeing more of them.

Sue and I have a grown-up daughter, Alice, who still lives in Poulton Le Fylde with two cats, several snakes and a gecko. You may be relieved to know there will just be two cats at our new Manse.

Theologically I'm hard to pin down, although I am a firm evangelical at heart. Inspired by the love of Jesus, at the core of my ministry is a deep love for people and a desire to help them develop both their personal and corporate discipleship within church and the wider community. Making disciples of Jesus is at the heart of everything I do. Through my preaching I seek to equip God's people for mission, evangelism and living as faithful disciples.

I think it's fair to say that I'm always serious about what I do, but not necessarily how I go about doing it.

My interests outside of theology include reading, especially Sherlock Holmes (both the originals and pastiches) and the Jeeves and Wooster novels by PG Wodehouse as

If you have a clean driving licence and are able to commit to offering a few hours of your time per month, we would love to hear from you!


