A Reflection during Lockdown



Just as the first lockdown happened in March 2019 I was temporarily living with my daughter's family in Manchester. I was ill and she kindly gave me a space to recuperate. The stay stretched to three months as the lockdown prevented me from returning home. As the year progressed, the Manchester household remained my bubble and my second home.

As with so many others, we looked to creative resourcefulness to pass the time.

This little stitched square records some of the elements of daily life. Looking at it now I see it's the story of a joyous time with my daughter, son-in-law, baby granddaughter and their pet cat. It records daily routines such as watching Richard Osman's House of Games; weekly events such as church, choir, quizzes and German class via Zoom and one-offs like us making spoof videos and organising menu nights. There are food treats - a glass of wine, Friday night crisps and

Prayer Focus Week at Wheatley Lane

Last week there was a Prayer Focus in the school which included the children being encouraged to write prayers for the Circuit prayer book and for displays at school. In addition to the usual prayer pattern in school there were organised prayer times for all year groups.

Three classes in Key Stage 2 each had a prayer time outside in the sunshine on separate days and they used a form of responsorial prayers which had been adapted from Iona Community. The children wrote a prayer or just named a situation or person on egg shaped cards. The children's prayers and the order of service have formed part of a display in the school. This focus of prayer was also linked to the start of Ramadan. The Revd Marian Taylor and Mrs Maureen Thornborrow led these sessions.

Then on Thursday Mrs Stella Brassington led creative prayer activities with the other classes in school in small groups.

We praise God for that the children experienced this Prayer focus in the school. Please continue to pray for all the three schools in the Circuit – Hapton, Wellfield and Wheatley Lane.
